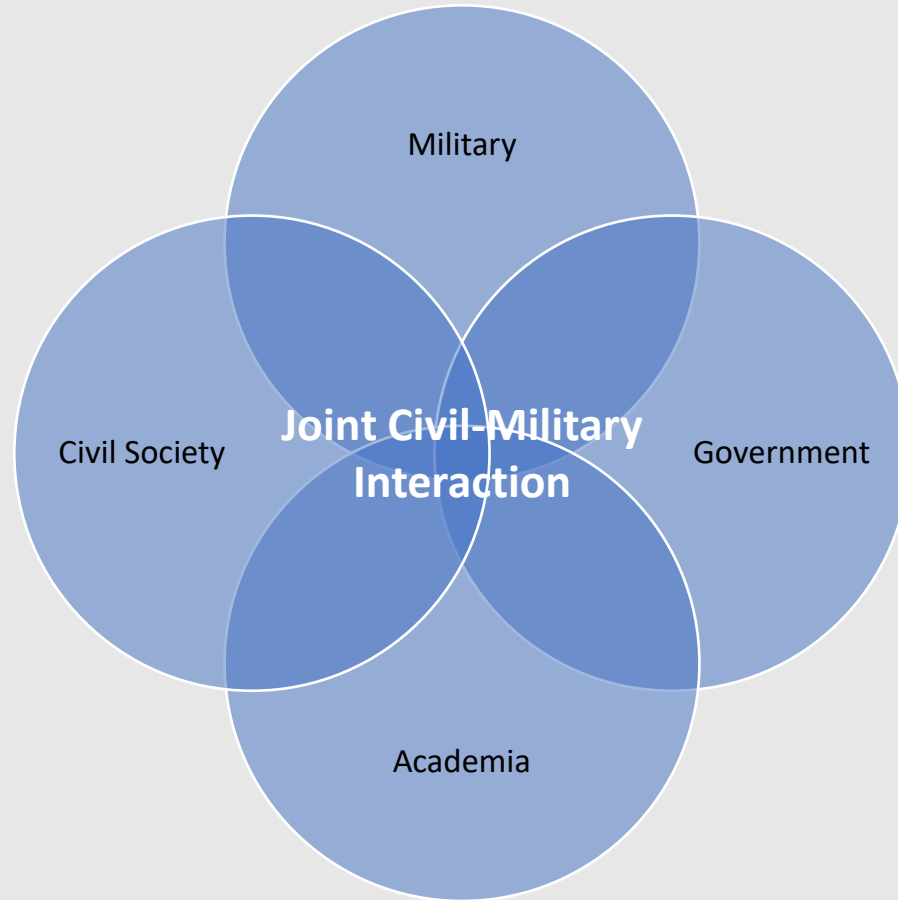


Mission

Joint Civil-Military Interaction (JCMI) is a comprehensive and seamless integration of civil society, military, governmental, and academic experts in defense, security, and crisis management to prepare wide-ranging expertise advising policy-makers and peacebuilding practitioners regarding civil-military integration in the shortest possible time avoiding competition to build societal resilience and sustainability.



Civil-Military Interaction

CMI is a **group of activities** founded on communication, planning, and coordination that military share and conduct with international, national, and local non-military actors before, during, and following military operations which mutually increases the effectiveness and efficiency of their respective actions in response to a crisis.

CMI is the **appropriate engagement**, governed by political decisions, between non-military and military actors. CMI is, therefore, a permanent means to optimize a multi-national military contribution to a coherent response to crises by the international community.
